



Laurel School Rules

Be Respectful

- Show respect to **all** people at Laurel
- No inappropriate language or touching
- Respect the belongings of others
- Aggressive behavior and racial slurs are not tolerated
- Dress appropriately for school – for example: no exposed undergarments, no open toe shoes, no short shorts (below mid thigh)
- Pick up after yourself. Place all trash in the trash can

Be Responsible

- Practice problem solving strategies to avoid escalating conflict
- Accept when you have made a mistake. Seek to learn from it and right the wrong
- No distracting toys allowed at school. Tools for learning allowed.
- Cell phones are to be turned off and kept out of sight
- No candy, soda, gum or soft drinks at school (chips are discouraged but can be eaten as part of complete school lunch)
- No food outside on playground lunch recess
- Food can be eaten outside at recess only in designated areas.
- No personal balls or sports equipment
- There is no need to bring money to school

Be Safe

- No play fighting
- **Student arrival between 8:15 and 8:30 (unless in before school care program)**
- No playing on the playground in the morning before the school day begins unless you are part of an organized game supervised by staff.
- Always walk in the hallways
- No students in the building before school, during recess and after school (unless with a teacher or part of a program)
- No playing in the bathrooms
- Never leave school campus during school hours without signing out first
- Stay within designated boundaries
